The call I made was a call I almost didn't make. In the regional finals game, one team had their kicker absolutely leveled by the receiving team. He kicked and then watched as the ball sailed about 45 yards out of bounds. As he watched the ball, a member of the receiving team came 15 yards at top speed and literally knocked him out. In watching my other keys for illegal blocks, etc., I almost missed it and was very late in dropping my flag. The call was bad only because it took so long but it was the right call to make. How I longed for perfection, and yet it was not to be. And the coach was upset because he did not know the rule. He argued it was fine to block the kicker (it is).



Contrast that with God the perfect, righteous judge. He never misses a call. He never misinterprets a rule. He is never busy with his "other keys." And His standards are such that I cannot hope to rise to a level to be worthy. Imagine, the things I do intentionally are judged but so are the things I do by omission. Hate is equal to murder and lust is the same as adultery. Wishing someone well if they are in a bad situation and doing nothing else is the same as taking no action at all.

The Bible says that "all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God."

Consider the implications of "fallen short." What if, on judgment day, we have "fallen short?" The answer is not bearable to imagine.

So, how can we even hope to stand before the perfect and righteous judge? While we can't Jesus can and, in God's perfect judgment, Jesus and only Jesus is found worthy. If, then, we are in Christ, a new creature...we are worthy not because of who we are or what we have done; but because we are covered by his righteousness.
