As I write this article, the junior high is firmly in the throes of its last day of benchmark testing for the TAKS test. These are not "the real" TAKS tests, but we treat them like they are. We have arranged and assigned seating, we post signs on our doors, we have hall monitors, and we follow all the TAKS rules.

Why? To help in two ways. First, we get an idea of how prepared we are for the real test and where we need to do the most work. Second, it gets the students used to the environment so that on TAKS day, it is not something for which they are unprepared. In school, we prepare for these big tests all year. Every day is aimed at one day in the spring. Every class is designed to meet the state curriculum. Even our small tests are designed to reflect the bigger test. But especially our study is designed for the test.

When I consider our faith, it is, or should be much the same. We receive little trials and temptations daily, things that we simply have to deal with along life's way. Maybe it is just our attitude when we have someone cut us off. Maybe it is our desire to have things our own way. But these small trials and temptations are simply preparing us for the big tests. If we train ourselves by studying, prayer, etc., we can pass these tests as well. The Bible tells us, "Finally, be strong in the Lord, and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, that you may be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the power, against the world forces in this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the full armor of God, that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm."

"Stand firm therefore, having girded your loins with truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the preparation of the Gospel of peace; in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming missiles of the evil one. And take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance..." (Ephesians 6:10-18, NASV).
