Robert and I were watching a video a couple of days ago of the youth group from 2006. It included such things as "The Wall Goes," Prom alternative, the Childress SNL and more. As we watched it, several people and several activities flashed across the screen that I did not know about and never knew existed. For example, the youth group painting a house; the youth weeding flower beds somewhere; and, of course, the rake and run.

But the thing I found most striking was that, in 2006 Will Landis was only 4 1/2 feet tall, Stephen Wilson was about 5 feet tall, and many of the youth that are here now weren't then. Others such as Nicole South and Aerial Sheppard have graduated and moved on while still others such as Kayla and Kelsey Clark, Jay and Melisa Poling (and family) have moved away. The dynamics of growth and change were overwhelming in proportion to the length of the video.

And that got me wondering, in the same 3 years, what has our personal growth and change looked like? As a biology teacher, I can assure you that change will happen. We grow and adapt or we die off. As a Christian, I can also assure you that we either grow, or we die off.

In order to grow, we need exercise and nutrition and rest. In order to die off, we simply have to neglect any of these things. The Bible says that we are as babes to crave the pure spiritual milk of the word. We are told to build our faith (exercise) on solid rock, we are told to prevail through struggles, to arm ourselves, and to train as a fighter or someone preparing for a race. And, we are told to rest in Him. When we do these things, we grow.

On the other hand, when we think we have it made; when we stop feasting on His word; We stop preparing for our future; we die.

So what about it. Have you grown from 4 1/2 feet to 6 feet? Or are you still struggling spiritually at 4 feet + a little. Spend some time with Him, and grow into the Christian you were meant to be.
