Now, there are no words that have greater ability to strike fear into hearts than these (unless it is, "I'm from the government and I'm here to help.") and I was no exception. But now that it ended last week, I can honestly say that this time, it wasn't so bad. You see, it ended with, "Your return was overpaid...you should receive a check for the amount of overpayment plus interest within the next ten business days."

Talk about relief! Not that it was a huge amount but I assure you we could not have paid it if it had gone the other way around.

Now, imagine judgment day. You have received not a letter from the IRS, but an appointment with the Creator, the Righteous Judge, the Almighty God to be judged in front of all of creation. But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to a new heaven and a new earth, the home of righteousness. So then, dear friends, since you are looking forward to this, make every effort to be found spotless, blameless and at peace with him. Bear in mind that our Lord's patience means salvation,"

Now that is much better than a surprise refund from the IRS. It is better than anything imaginable. And so, dear friends, my challenge for this week, live with the end in sight. Keep your eyes on the prize and live for him.

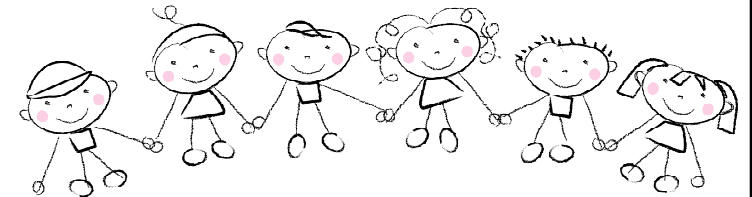
